Class 2. Intermediate. Horses/Ponies not to have won £20.00 show jumping.

Class 4. Open. Open to all except those entered in class 1

Height max 80cm first round

Height max 90cm first round

Entries for dressage close the Thursday before each show and times will be available on the Friday before each show by phoning 01899 810304 between 7pm and 9pm. Entries accepted for the Showjumping before or on the field.

Entry fees are as follows: Dressage: Intro, Prelim and Novice £8.00

Elementary £9.00

First Aid Cover £1.00 per rider

Showjumping: Clear round £6.00

All other classes £8.00

First Aid Cover £1.00 per rider
