**Class 2 - Restricted Novice** - Combination of horse & rider not to have won more than five Jumping classes. Fences 2'6 max.  
**Class 3 - Open Novice** – Fences 2'6 max.  
**Class 4 - Scurry** – Fences approx. 2'6  
**Class 5 - Intermediate** – Fences 2'9 max.  
**Class 6 - Open** – Fences 3'3 max  
**Class 7 - Chase Me Charlie** – Fences start 2'9 - **Entries allowing.**

Rosettes to be awarded 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> for all classes.

### **Rules**

1. All horses to be **4 years and over** and all riders to be **16 years or over**.
2. Strictly no dogs.
3. A hard hat to EN1384 or PAS015 must be worn, with a dark cover, by all mounted riders whether competing or not. All hats prefixed SEI or ASTM are not acceptable. A chin strap, which has a non-detachable retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points, should be used. Any rider found to be using a hat to a lower specification will be disqualified.
4. Neither the organisers of this event, nor any person acting on their behalf, the owners of the show ground or agents acting on their behalf, accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
5. The judge's decision is final. Any complaints to be made in writing to the secretary and accompanied by £10 and the complaint made within one hour of the incidence.
6. Entry fees only refunded if the show is cancelled, classes are full, or if you cannot compete after the entry but agree to help at the show if this is required. An administration fee may be taken from each competitor.
7. There will be a limited number in each class. Each horse can be entered in a maximum of 4 classes.
8. EDRC members will receive league table points, points allocated to 6th place in all classes. Memberships must be fully paid up to qualify for points.
