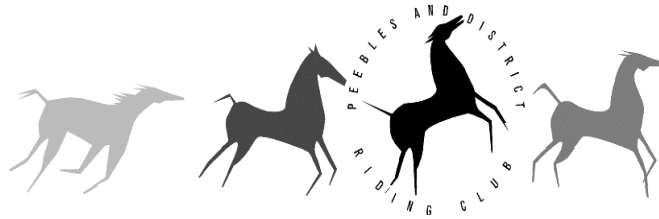

1. The competition is run under official Riding Club rules
2. The Judge's decision is final
3. All competitors must be paid up members of a BHS affiliated Riding Club or Pony Club
4. All under 18's must be accompanied by an adult as Peebles & District take no responsibility for any harm that may come to them
5. Riders must wear a hard hat conforming to BSEN1384 or PAS015 with the harness properly adjusted and fastened. Failure to do so will incur a £10 fine and request to leave the event
6. Classes may be split/combined or cancelled at the Committee's/judge's discretion
7. Horses must be 4 years old or over
8. Peebles and District Riding Club accept no responsibility for any accident, loss or damage to persons, animals or property whatsoever
9. Objections to be made in writing within one hour of the class with £10 deposit which will be returned if the complaint is upheld
- 10.No refunds can be given after the closing date
- 11.In the event of cancellation, 75% of entry fees will be refunded to those who request it
- 12.Please don't muck out horseboxes onto the showground, a fine of £20 will be issued to anyone caught doing so.
- 13.Parking is limited so please consider fellow competitors and park as close as possible to allow maximum space to be used.
- 14.A banksman must be used when reversing at all times, ask one of the stewards to help if you are travelling alone.
- 15.No horse should be left unattended while tied to a horse box
- 16.Stallions can only be brought to a show with prior notification and permission granted from the entries secretary
- 17.ALL dogs must be kept on leads

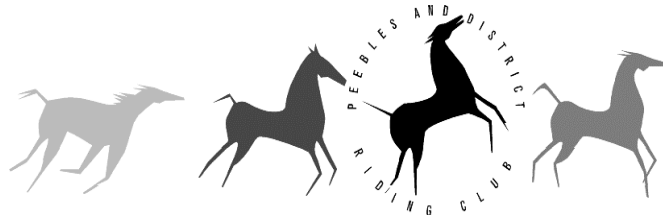

From the A720, Edinburgh City Bypass.

Take the Lothianburn exit near Hillend Ski Centre, signposted for Biggar and the A702, follow this road for approximately 23 miles. On approach into Biggar (just before the 30mph signs), the showground is situated on your Left Hand Side, the entrance to the show field has large red gates.

Please signal well in advance and drive with care.

From the M74

Take J13 towards Edinburgh, near Abington services, follow the A702 towards Edinburgh for 12 miles, make your way carefully through Biggar High St. Just as you are leaving Biggar, the showfield is located on your Right Hand Side, just after the national speed limit signs. The entrance has large red gates.

Please signal well before turning and drive with caution.
